ABOUT YOUR REPORT PACK

Your report pack gives you a comparison to a statistically significant national data set, by comparing your school's teacher assessments against other schools who use one of Juniper Education's tracking solutions.

The analysis looks at the attainment data for Reading, Writing and Mathematics and compares it to the Juniper Education national benchmark. Your pack will provide you with headline data for whole school, individual year groups and contextual groups.

What data has been used, and what is being compared

- We've used c.6,500 schools' teacher assessments that took place in the Autumn term 2023-2024.
- We have only included pupils who were on-roll as of 31-12-2023.
- We compared each pupil's summative teacher assessment against the age-related expectation (ARE).
- Using this we created a 'flag' to determine if the pupil was below, at or above ARE.
- We then aggregated these 'flags' to create a total figure of pupils that were at and above ARE.
- Finally, we used the total number of pupils with a teacher assessment to create a percentage figure of pupils who are at and above ARE.
- The data used to create this 'flag' was a snapshot of your tracker on 31-12-2023.

How we calculate your percentages

We understand the importance of transparency and therefore we have included the formula that we've used below:

(Number of pupils in each year group at your school, assessed as 'at' or 'above' ARE / Number of pupils in each year group in your school) x 100

This is then compared to:

(Number of pupils in each year group in all Juniper Tracker schools, assessed as 'at' or 'above' ARE / Number of pupils in each year group in the entire Juniper dataset) x 100

An example would be: Example Primary School has 100 pupils in Year 6, 50 pupils were assessed as 'at' or 'above' ARE, so the calculation would be $(50/100) \times 100 = 50\%$.

Local Authority averages

We have included average data for **Buckinghamshire** to give you an additional comparison with schools local to you. As the number of schools using Juniper Tracker software varies by region this should be taken into consideration when drawing any conclusions.

There are 43 Buckinghamshire schools with Juniper Tracker data for this assessment point.

ABOUT YOUR REPORT PACK

How you can use your benchmark report:

- Take a look at your data compared to the Juniper average. It may not directly correlate to published standards and statutory assessment data, but it will give you insight that no other report can:
 - It is live data based on a nationally significant snapshot of the exact time it was taken of over 6,500 schools and over 1.5 million pupils. No other data set in the country can provide that 'live' view of data.
 - Whilst the ultimate individual result against reported data may be a snapshot. You should consider the following indicators to feed into your attainment reporting and development plans:
 - how your school tracks and compares in each subject, particularly when compared against one another,
 - how each vulnerable group compares and its relative gap to national data.
- Consider your action plans from this, think about reviewing areas of discrepancy and how they might be tackled, what intervention might be required.

- If any data has been updated in your tracker since the date this pack was created, the analysis in this document may not precisely match the analysis in your tracking system.
- No pupil level data has been copied from your tracker to create this report. We calculated the number and percentages in your tracker and only used this summary level data to produce the report.

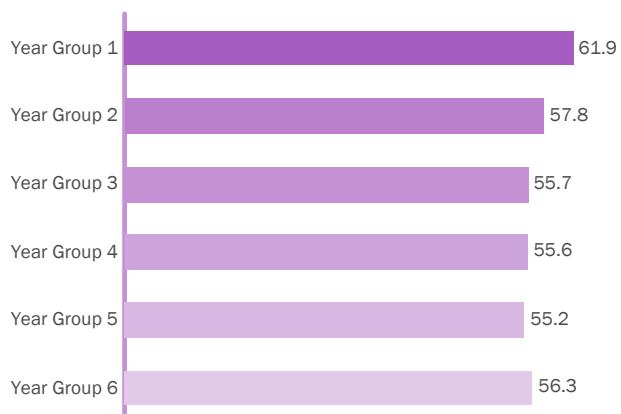
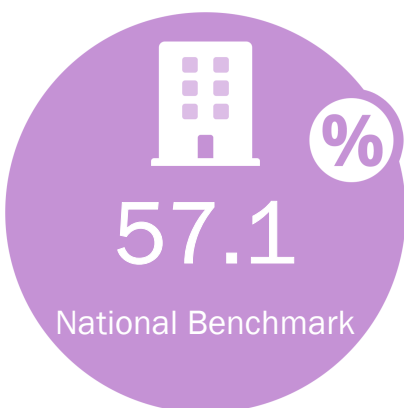
School - Year Group Age-Related Expectation Analysis

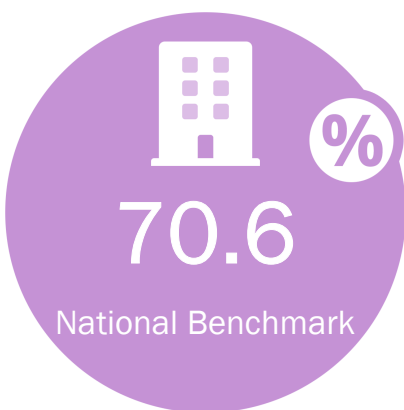

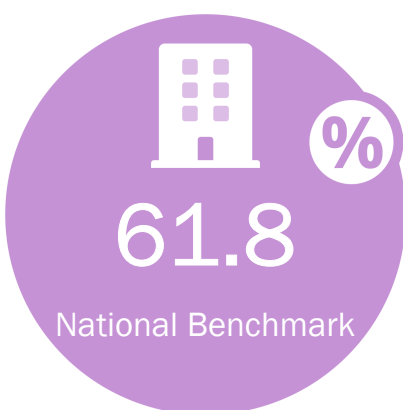

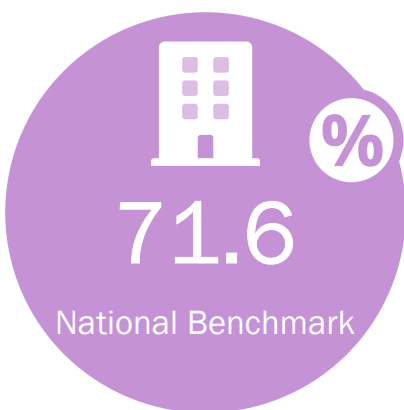
School - Year Group Age-Related Expectation Analysis
